

Swydd-ddisgrifiad Gweithiwr i'r Ifanc (Ynys Môn)

Teitl y swydd: Gweithiwr Ysgolion, Eglwysi a Chymunedau

Diben a phwrpas: Cydlynnu a chynnal gwaith Cristnogol ymysg plant a phobl ifanc mewn ysgolion (Ysgolion Cyfun, yn bennaf), Eglwysi a chymunedau ar Ynys Môn. Parhau, datblygu a gwireddu cynlluniau, fydd yn sicrhau presenoldeb Cristnogol mewn ysgolion ac Eglwysi ac yn cyfoethogi'r ddarpariaeth honno drwy gydweithio gydag eraill.

Atebolrwydd: Bydd y sawl a benodir yn atebol am bob agwedd ar ei waith/ei gwaith i Ymddiriedolwyr Gobaith Môn ac i'w Reolwr/Rheolwr Llinell.

Crynodeb o gyfrifoldebau'r swydd:

- A. **Gwaith mewn ysgolion:** cynrychioli a chyflwyno'r ffydd Gristnogol, ennyn buchedd Gristnogol a chefnogi gwaith ymysg plant a phobl ifanc. Cynnal cynlluniau sydd eisoes wedi eu sefydlu a chynorthwyo mentrau newydd.
- B. **Gwaith mewn eglwysi:** sefydlu a datblygu'r cyswllt gydag eglwysi a'u galluogi hwy, pan ddaw'r cyfle, i weithredu ac ymestyn eu hymwneud â phlant a phobl ifanc yn eu cymuned.
- C. **Gwaith cymunedol:** Parodwyrdd i ymwneud â gwaith ymysg yr ifanc a sefydliadau sy'n cynrychioli'r ifanc a chynlluniau sydd heb gyswllt gydag unrhyw eglwys (e.e. datblygu parc chwaraeon yn Llangefni)

Gweithgaredd craidd:

- A. Arwain a chyfrannu l wersi yn yr ysgol, gwasanaethau boreol a chyfarfodydd Cristnogol rheolaidd.
- B. Ymwneud a chefnogi'r ysgol a'i chymuned yn y modd mwyaf priodol
- C. Cynorthwyo grwpiau Cristnogol newydd i gael eu sefydlu – naill ai mewn ysgolion neu eglwysi, neu grwpiau o eglwysi drwy sicrhau nodau ac amcanion priodol.
- CH. Hyfforddi: denu, cynorthwyo a chefnogi interniaid newydd a gwirfoddolwyr er mwyn datblygu a hyrwyddo'r gwaith
- D. Cyd-weithio, datblygu a hyfforddi ar gyfer gwaith newydd mewn ysgolion – yn enwedig drwy gynorthwyo gwirfoddolwyr [e.e. wrth ddefnyddio adnoddau S.U. yn genedlaethol].
- Dd. Trefnu gweithgaredd rhwng y grwpiau gwahanol, pan fo'n briodol.

Gweithgaredd eilaidd:

- E. Meithrin cysylltiadau rhwng ysgolion ac Eglwysi fel bod gan yr Eglwysi ofal a chonsym ymarferol am athrawon a disgyblion, ac awydd i gefnogi Cristnogion yn eu plith.
- F. Dal cyswllt gyda Gweithwyr Ysgolion eraill o fewn rhwydwaith leol a chenedlaethol – a hynny mewn cydweithrediad â'r Rheolwr Llinell.
- Ff. Mynychu cyfarfodydd 'Scripture Union' ac unrhyw gyrsiau hyfforddi eraill a chynadleddau
- G. Ymdrechu i ddatblygu doniau a sgiliau personol a phroffesiynol drwy astudio a hyfforddiant. Cynhelir Adolygiad Perfformiad blynyddol.
- Ng. Disgwylir i'r sawl a benodir i fod yn gyfrifol am weinyddu ei holl waith yn effeithiol.
- H. I ymgymeryd â chyfrifoldebau eraill yn unol â dymuniad y Rheolwr Llinell.

Disgwylir i'r sawl a benodir i swydd 'Gweithiwr i'r Ifanc' fod yn cynnal a chreu cysylltiadau gydag ysgolion ac Eglwysi, gan gydnabod fod gweithgareddau o'r fath mewn ysgolion ac Eglwysi yn fentrau o'u heiddo hwy ac yn ddibynnol ar wahoddiad a derbyn eu caniatad.

Job Description

Anglesey Young People's ["Youth"] Worker

Job Title: Schools, Churches & Community Worker

Purpose

Facilitating and doing Christian work with Children and Young People in Schools [Predominately Secondary], Churches and Community on the Island of Anglesey. To continue to develop an enabling, facilitating role, so that a Christian presence in Schools and Churches may flourish, maintained and enhanced, and to work with others to that end.

Accountability

The worker is accountable, for all aspects of his / her work, to the Trustees of Gobaith Mon and a Line Manager.

Summary of Functions

- A.Schools work: which includes advocating the Christian faith, lifestyle and support work with children and young people. To maintain existing work and help new initiatives.
- B.Church work: which includes developing and maintaining contact with Churches, and enabling them, when opportunity presents, to be involved / extend their involvement with children and young people in their localities.
- C.Community: Be open to opportunities to be involved with local Youth organisations or initiatives which are not primarily Church-led (e.g. Development of Urban Sports Park in Llangefni)

Activities

KEY ACTIVITIES

- A. To lead/take part in school lessons, assemblies, and regular Christian group meetings.
- B. To be involved in and supportive of the school community in appropriate ways.
- C. To help new Christian groups to set up, either in Schools or local Churches, or groups of Churches, establishing appropriate aims and objectives.
- D.Training: to recruit, resource and support interns and volunteers for the furtherance of the work.
- E.To work with /develop /train for other school work initiatives, especially where volunteers are involved [e.g. using resources written by S.U. nationally].
- F.To organise inter-group events where appropriate.

SECONDARY ACTIVITIES

- G. To develop ways of linking Schools and Churches so that Church groups have an active concern for teachers and pupils and a desire to support any Christians among them.
- H. To maintain contact with other Schools Workers within the close and wider network, in consultation with the Line Manager.
- I. To attend the Scripture Union and other relevant Training Courses and Conferences.
- J. To undertake personal and professional developments by study and training and participate in an annual work review.
- K. To be responsible for effective administration of their work.
- L. To undertake other duties as assigned by their Line Manager.

It is expected that the Young People's Worker will be pro-active in maintaining and making contact with Schools and Churches, whilst recognising that all such activities within Schools and Churches are at the Schools' / Churches' invitation and approval.
